


# THE MESSENGER



I have never been much of a "numbers guy," particularly when it comes to my relationship with God and the church.

When I was growing up in the church, we had offering envelopes that had a check list on the front that evaluated things like: Did I read my Bible every day? How many visits or contact did I make in a week? How much was I placing in a tithe or offering for the week?

In the old days, the sanctuary had a sign board on the walls that recorded attendance in worship, Sunday school, Discipleship Training, and total giving for the week.

We are supposed to do an annual report each year to the Southern Baptist Convention relating these types of numbers.

But a few years ago someone compared these numbers to that of "vital signs" taken when you go see a doctor, you know, height, weight, blood pressure, temperature.... They are simply superficial indicators of how you are doing in that moment. If you don't make too much out of them but also don't ignore them, they can be useful.

Our "God and church" can do the same thing.

The Discipline of Worship

I give regularly, systematically, and
sacrificially to the work of God
through my church

people who are less fortunate
than me.
