

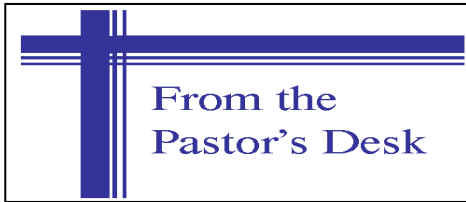

When I was working as a school counselor, one of the most tragic circumstances I encountered (more than once) was a child who had been abused and neglected as an infant and baby. They often had severe behavior problems, difficulty coping and some required extensive psychiatric help, even being institutionalized for periods of time. I really saw little hope for many of them unless there was a direct intervention from God. But just as some children who are abused and neglected struggle greatly, children who are placed on a solid foundation of faith, nurture, and security often cope and function well even during great traumatic events in their lives.

I have no doubt that one function of the church, in conjunction with the family, is to provide a solid foundation of faith in Christ.

Jesus rebuked his disciples when they attempted to send away parents and their children who had come to be blessed by Jesus. Jesus understood how important that ministry was to His Kingdom and He was not going to neglect it.

We, as a church in imitation of Christ, must not neglect the ministry to our young children. We need a core group of faithful servants and teachers who are committed to revealing the love of Christ to these children, building on that foundation.

We continue to grow in our pre-school and nursery and what a blessing it is to have an abundance of children gracing our fellowship and facility. With that I am going to ask you to do one simple thing: Sincerely pray Jesus' prayer in Matthew 9:37-38.

"The harvest is plentiful but the workers are few."

Ask the Lord of the harvest, therefore, to send out workers into his harvest field. One field that needs attention now is our pre-school. Please pray and ask God if you are to be one of the workers sent.

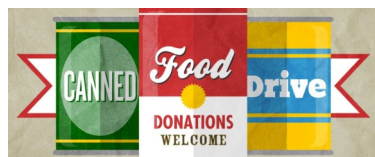
The window blinds in the Fellowship Hall are being replaced.
